AIRPORT SECURITY BULLETIN



ENHANCED AVIATION WORKER INSPECTIONS

In accordance with Transportation Security Administration (TSA) requirements, all individuals attempting to enter, entering into, and present within any security-controlled area of the airport are subject to and must submit to inspection of their person, their vehicles, and any property or items in their possession.

It is important to remember that refusal to submit to inspections or attempting to enter with (or possession of) unauthorized weapons, firearms, explosives, and/or incendiaries in the security-controlled areas is prohibited and will result in penalties including but not limited to revocation of an airport ID badge.

Inspections may be conducted by personnel from the TSA, MWAA Police, and/or MWAA Security Representatives. These inspections are intended to detect and prevent unauthorized weapons, firearms, explosives, incendiaries, and other prohibited items.
