

Passenger Walkway to Concourses A and B

Customer Benefit:

This underground walkway provides passengers with an option to using the Mobile Lounges today, as well as the future automated Airport Train System, as a way to travel between the Terminal and Concourses A and B. The walkway is equipped with moving sidewalks in each direction.

Project Description:

Included in this project is the construction of the structural shell and architectural finishes for the 40-foot wide and 27-foot high tunnel, including elevators, escalators, stairways, and moving sidewalks. The walkway is approximately 1,000 feet long. Passengers can walk between the Terminal and Concourses A and B. In the future, this walkway will be extended to connect Concourse B with a future permanent Concourse C.
